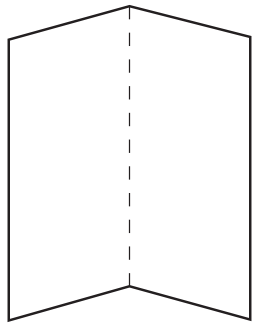


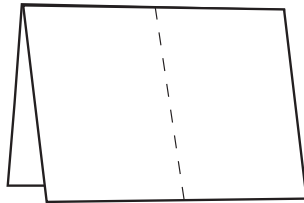
# PAPER BOAT

Create a paper boat that really floats!

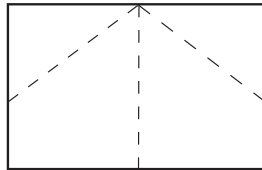
A paper boat is a form of origami - paper art made without cutting or pasting.



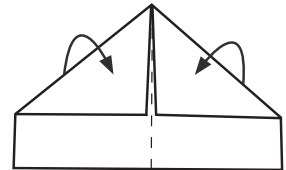
1. Fold the long side of a sheet of paper.



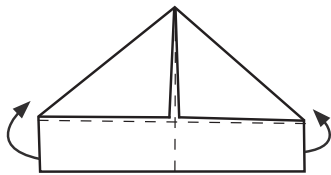
2. Fold the other side in half.



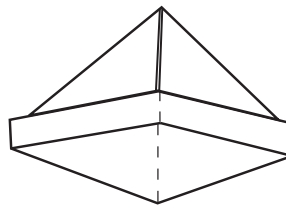
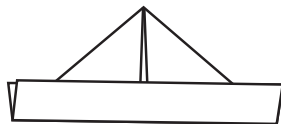
3. Lay flat on a table.



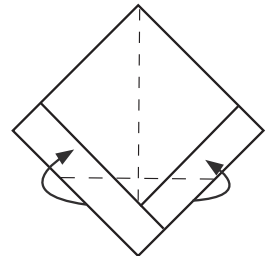
4. Fold down the corners.



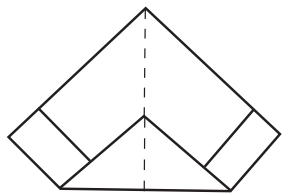
5. Fold the bottom flaps up as shown on both sides.



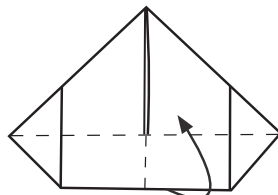
6. Put your hand underneath and pop open to invert. Fold flat.



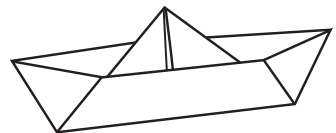
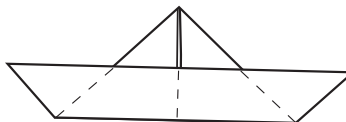
7. Flip up the bottom flap as shown on both sides.



8. Put your hand underneath and invert again.

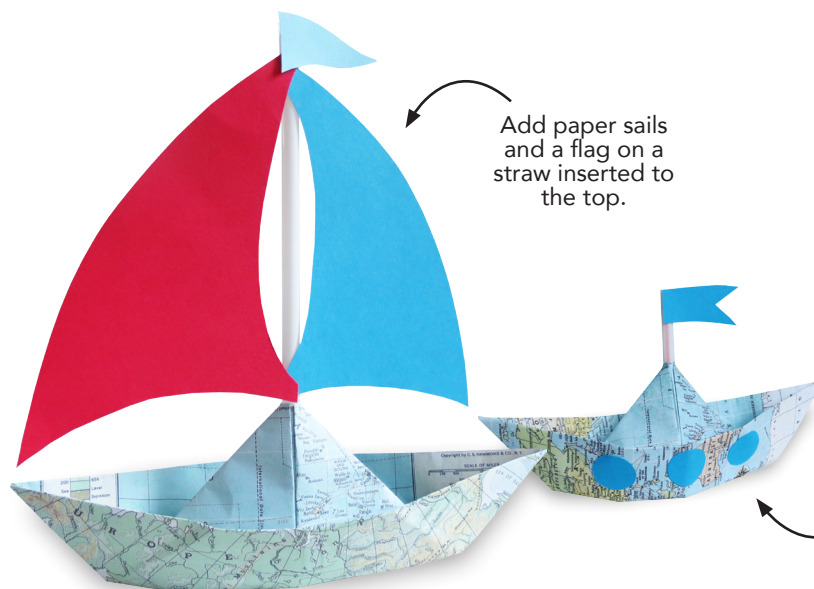


9. Flip up the flaps as shown on both sides to form a boat.



10. Pop open the boat to give it shape.

Use maps, newspaper or patterned paper to make boats.

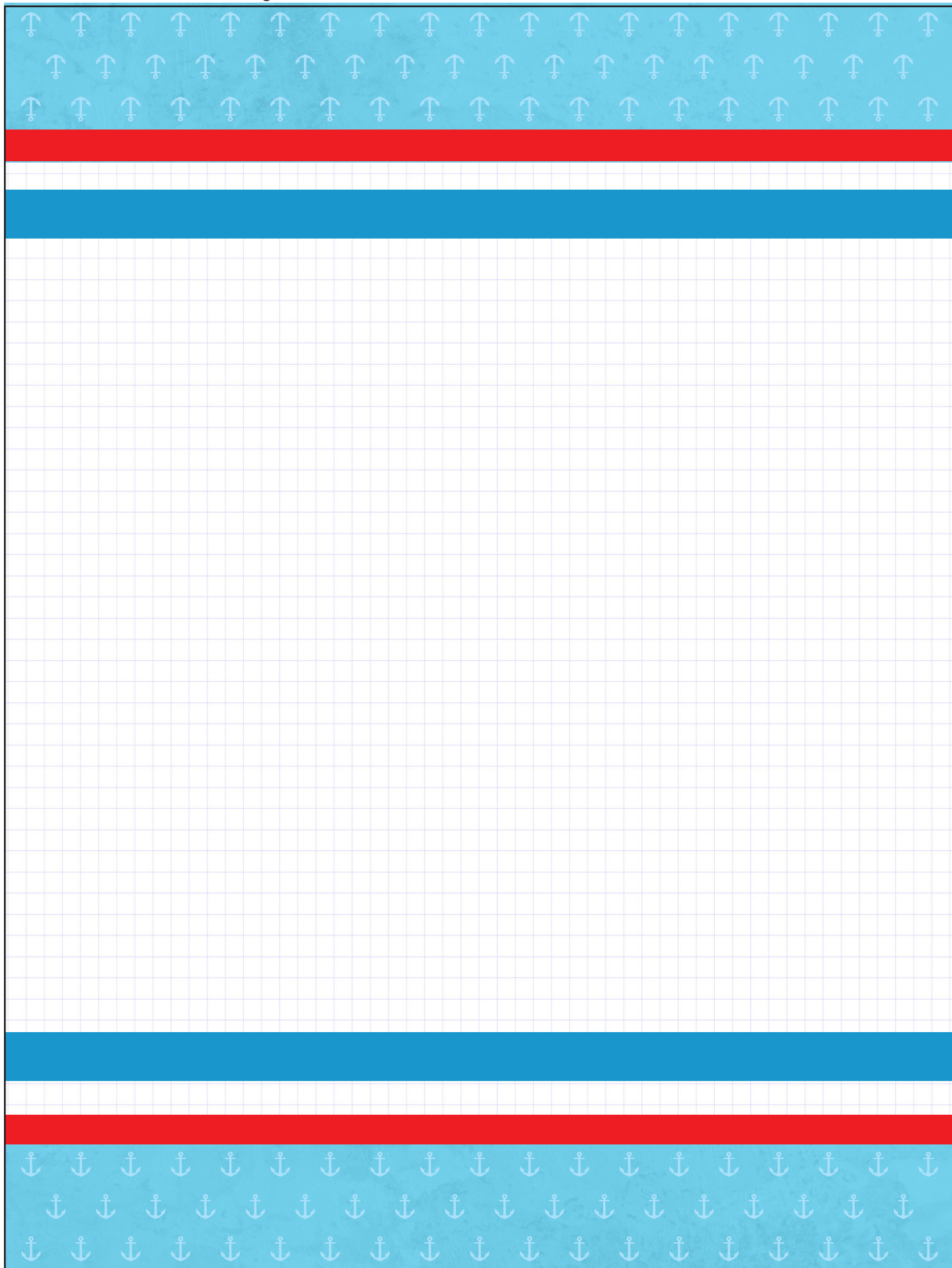


Add paper sails and a flag on a straw inserted to the top.

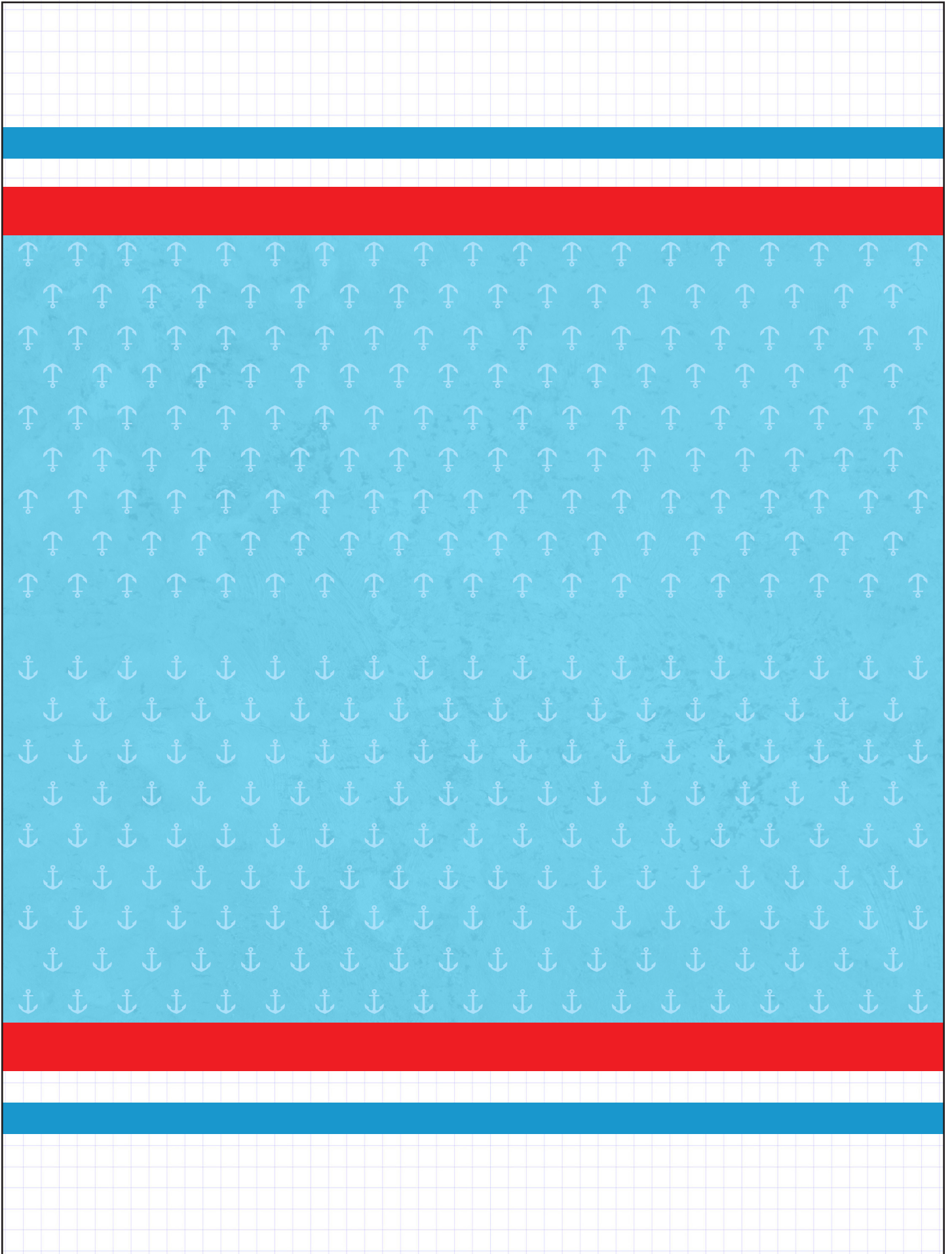
Boats sailing together is called a regatta.

Decorate the sides with portholes, anchors and other details.
